

Letter of Direction – Youth Sports Participation Fund V1

This letter confirms the direction of funds raised by **Bring ‘Em Up Sask (“BEUS”)** in support of youth sports participation.

BEUS agrees that **25% of net funds raised**, after deducting gala costs, camp expenses, and related fundraising expenses, will be provided to **Regina Open Door Society Inc. (“RODS”)**.

These funds are to be used by RODS, at its discretion, to support initiatives that foster access to sports for newcomer and refugee children and youth at large, and to help bridge barriers to participation where needs are identified.

The remaining net funds will be retained and managed by BEUS. BEUS will use these funds to support individual athletes through its athlete support application process, including the review, selection, and disbursement of funds to approved applicants.

RODS will track expenditures related to the funds received and provide summary reporting to BEUS on how the funds were used, once a year in April. This will be reviewed by both parties annually.

Thank you for your commitment to empowering youth, supporting newcomer and refugee families, and helping young people access opportunities to participate in sport.
